Easter, or Resurrection Sunday, is a festival and holiday commemorating the resurrection of Jesus from the dead.

Pesach, is the Hebrew word for Passover. This is where we get the term Paschal Moon that helps to date Easter Sunday. In the story of the first Passover, Moses tells the Israelites to slaughter a lamb and paint its blood on their doors and sides of the doorframe. The Lord protected the Israelites from death by passing over their doors and would not "allow the destroyer to enter [their] houses to strike [them] down" (Ex. 12:23). In verse 26 Moses tells his people to tell their children that "it is the Passover Sacrifice to the Lord, who passed over the houses of the Israelites."

In the New Testament (1 Corinthians 5:7), Paul connects the resurrected Christ to Passover. He refers to Jesus as the Passover Lamb who has been sacrificed for his people's salvation. Jesus celebrated the Last Supper with his disciples on Thursday of Passover week. We now celebrate the resurrected Christ on the first full moon after March 21.

At SMBC we will celebrate the Resurrected Christ throughout Holy Week beginning with **Palm Sunday, April 10**. Children will help us celebrate in a Palm leaves processional at the beginning of each service. Wednesday night we will look at the (Monday-Wednesday) activities of Christ.

**Maundy Thursday** is another name for the Holy Thursday, the first of 3 days of solemn remembrance of the events leading up to and following the crucifixion of Jesus.

Our Maundy Thursday service this year will be based on the seven last words of Christ. Loyd Wells will be sharing thoughts on these seven passages of scripture, and we will add music from the adult choir as well as congregational music and readings. The celebration is always a bit more meaningful when time is spent remembering and understanding the cost that provides for the celebration. I hope you can **join us at 7:00 PM** as we spend time together focusing on both **Maundy Thursday events and Good Friday**.

**Saturday**, our children will want to be part of the **Easter Eggstravaganza** helicopter egg drop\hunt and games.

You won't want to miss our **Easter Sunday services at 8:15 and 10:45**. On Easter Sunday Dr. Billings will be speaking on the Cradle, the Cross, and the Crown. Wonderful times of worship are in store for us throughout this special season.
