When the small Texas town I previously pastored in was being overwhelmed with hospitalizations and deaths amidst the peak of the pandemic, multiple churches within that community joined together for a prayer vigil. We gathered in the parking lot to stretch along the exterior of the hospital rooms where patients were isolated on the inside. It was there we asked for God's mercy to be applied to those suffering. Not long after someone gave the final amen, a news reporter who discovered I was the pastor responsible for organizing the event began asking me questions on what compelled us to take such action. Once the camera stopped rolling, he handed me his business card and said something I never expected a news reporter to say. "If you or your church do things like this again, call me...people are dying to hear some good news." They say you can't believe everything you hear on the news, but I believe that reporter was right. People are dying to hear some good news all throughout Texas. The question then becomes: "How are we going to deliver it to them?" There's a multitude of ways to go about such a task. Here are a couple of ways to begin in September by partnering with South Main.
